

RULES FOR ADMINISTRATION

- 1. Application for admission should be made in the prescribed format only. Forms of application should be obtained from the college office by playing a prescribed fee.
- 2. No admission will be made after the last date which has been fixed by the Rani Channamma University, Belagavi.
- 3. All admission made to the college are provisional and subject to the approval of the Rani Channamma University, Belagavi.

- 4. Only those candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations as prescribed by the Rani Channamma University, Belagavi are eligible for admission.
- 5. Admission to any course is made for one academic year only. Students will be admitted to the next higher class on the basis of fresh application for admission to that class taking into Account the progress conduct and behavior of each student during the previous year in the College.
- 6. Candidates should bring with them prescribed certificates, documents and fees for Admission.
- 7. The students enrolling in B.A., B.Sc., and B.Com. I, II, or III class, from State other than Karnataka will have to pay eligibility fee as prescribed by the Rani Channamma University, Belagavi.
- 8. No students coming from outside the state and not passing the P.U.C. Courses of this State will be admitted without obtaining an eligibility certificate by Rani Channamma University, Belagavi.
- 9. Students joining the College from other Colleges in this University area are required to apply immediately for their Transfer Certificates, in prescribed form through this College by playing prescribed fees, to college last attached by them.
- 10. The Principal may refuse admission to any student without giving any reasons.

CODE OF CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION

- > Examinations schedule was fixed as per the RCU, guidelines.
- > Two tests are conducted on 8th and 12th week if each semester.
- Assignment are collected for every semester
- > Performance of the candidate in tests and assignments are displayed on the notice board.
- > Valued answer paper are discussed in the classroom.
- > Attendance for the examination is compulsory.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. Every student of this College should posses the identity Card with his/her photo fixed on it Duly attested by the Principal.
- 2. Students should have their Identity Card when they go the Library, Laboratory Examination hall, Gymkhana and college office. The Identity Card must be produced Whenever demanded by any member of the college staff.
- 3. Students desirous of having the character certificate/ study certificate should apply at least 3 days in advance along with prescribed fees of Rs.50/-. These certificates will be issued only if the students has no dues.
- 4. All the payments such as scholarship, refund of caution money etc., will be made through cheques and the cheques will be issued on production of Identity Card.
- 5. The caution money will lapse to the college;
 - a] If not claimed within 6 months after the first day of the term following the term last attended or
 - b] If the student discontinues the course before paying the tuition and other fees.
- 6. Once a student takes admission to the College and discontinues any time of the academic year, he/she will have to pay entire fees.

- 7. Transfer certificate will not handed over to the students in person but will be sent to the Institution to which he/she intended to join. The application for T.C. should be countersigned by the Head of the Instruction and accompanied by a Bank Challan. of Rs. 100/- payable to the Principal, S.S.M.S. College, Athani. The T. C. will be issued, only when the student has no dues in this College.
- 8.If the student has less than 80% attendance in any subject/s he/she/ will detained from appearing for the examination of the year.

RULES OF DISCIPLINE

- 1. Students shall be regular and punctual and shall attend all the period according to the time –table and special classes arranged in the college.
- 2. No students is allowed to remain absent for the Tests Examination m without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 3. No student is allowed to stand or loiter about the Varandah of the College during college hours.
- 4. Students are forbidden to write or make any marks on the walls, desk or furniture.
- 5. No students shall communicate any information relating to college to the press without the written permission of the Principal.
- 6. No person shall invited to address a college meeting or Association without the permission of the Principal.
- 7. Students must not attend any other class except their own.
- 8. No students within the campus of the college shall carry out any activities associated with any political party or organization which take part in politics.
- 9. Smoking, chewing, tobacco, gutkha, chewing gum and use of mobile phones in the college premises is very strictly prohibited.
- 10. No student shall misbehave with any parent guardian teacher, student or any employee of the college.
- 11. Students of the college, are not allowed to play in any outside team without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 12. No tours, excursions, picnics or pleasure trips are to be arranged without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 13. All equipments and materials of the College shall be handled with care by the students.
- 14. The outsiders are not allowed to enter the college campus without ID Card and prior permission of the Principal.
- 15. The Principal may frame and notify any rules of discipline and they shall be binding on all the students.
- 16. The students who violate these ru9 will be liable for fine or expulsion or will not be admitted in the college in the subsequent years.
- 17. The decision of the Principal is final in all these matters.
- 18. The college campus is under the surveillance of CCTV Camera.

NOMINATETION FOR CLASS REPRESENTATIVES AND ASSOCIATION

- Class representatives and secretaries of various association will be nominated from among the students by a committee to be appointed by the Principal, generally on the basis of merit.
- The Principal shall have the power to delete or amend any of the rules and to frame any new rules as and when he feels necessary.
- > In all matters the decision of the Principal shall be final and binding.

LIBRARY RULES:

- The Library will be keep open from Monday to Saturday @ 9:00 A.M to 6:00 P.M and on Sunday Between 9:00A.M to 1:00 P.M. During the examination Period @ 9:00 A.M to 8:00 P.M
- Each student will be issued a Borrower's Ticket in the Library on production of his/her Identity Card.
- > Only one book will be issued on production and in exchange of the Borrower Ticket.
- Book lent home shall be returned not later than the 7 days from the date of issued. Delay in returning the book will cost a fine of Rs 1/- per day.
- The student shall collect his/her Borrower Ticket as soon as he/she returned the borrower book.
- Any damage to the book borrowed, disfiguring or tearing the pages, diagrams or photographs will be very severely dealt with.
- If the Borrower Ticket or Identify Card is lost, the student shall have to pay Rs.10/- to obtain a fresh ticket or card.
- Books, Magazines, Journals, Periodicals can be borrowed for reference within the library premises only in exchange of the identity card, such a book shall not be taken outside the Library under any circumstances.

CERTICATE COURSES:


